Competition Conditions

- Rules:** All competitions will be run under ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage (ED 2017)
- Responsibility:** It is the Rider or Persons Responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this show. Conditions are published in the programme and this schedule.
- Official start time:** The official event start time is 8am Friday 26 January. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations, Veterinary Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time of the event must be entered at the event unless special permission is granted by the OC. Please note Dressage NZ rules do not allow the use of prohibited gear from time of arrival on the grounds.
- Amendments:** The OC reserves the right to alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ GR's/Dressage NZ Rules.
- Balloting:** In all levels, horses/ponies may be balloted if there are excessive entries. In principle there will be a limit of approx 35 starters per class. Riders should submit the horse/pony best 3 scores and the average of these scores at Regional or National Events in the level entered since 1 January 2016 and if balloting is required, priority will be given to the best performed horses on this basis. If this information is not provided for any horse or pony they will be first to be put on the wait list.

6. **Upgradings:** Please notify Miranda Luddington immediately. Failure to do so prior to show will result in no refund and additional entry fees charged. Other changes at event, a fee of \$15 per class is applicable.
7. **Scratching's** -Please advise if you are not going to compete on the day or you will be eliminated. To be eligible for a refund see rules on Withdrawal Form and this must be received by 24 January 2018
8. **Presentation of Prizes & Prize Money:** See article 485. Presentation times will be advised in the program. The OC reserves the right to substitute prize money with goods to the equal value. Prize money will only be paid for scores of 57% and above. All prize money will be paid by Direct Credit within 21 days of the event. You must ensure your bank account number is loaded into Equestrian Entries, otherwise prize money cannot, and will not be paid. The OC reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a place getter not attend an advertised prize giving. Riders who have conflicting class times must nominate another person to Miranda Luddington via the event office to collect their prizes/rosettes at the prize giving.
9. **Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available 7.00 pm on the results board. The OC reserves the right to alter the program to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
10. **Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
11. **Riders with more than 2 horses:** The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
12. **Ponies:** Pony riders may compete at Levels 1-4 only on registered ponies. Pony Champions and Reserve Sashes will be awarded at all 4 levels.
13. **South Island Rider Meeting:** TBC but most likely Friday 26 January 5.30pm outside the Main Marquee. All rider's attendance is strongly recommended

Zilco Musical Freestyles

The competition comprises two Island Leaderboards

1. The NI Leaderboard completes at the HOYS
2. The SI Leaderboard completes at the SI Festival of Dressage
3. The Leaderboard points are gained at regional area qualifying shows and Island championships.
4. Leaderboard Points are allocated at regional events and are attributed to the island Leaderboard in which they are earned regardless of the origin of the horse or rider

Eligibility

Horses/ponies may start in only one level at each event.

Horses/ponies downgraded as schoolmasters are eligible to compete in the qualifiers and gain Leaderboard points but may not compete in finals at SICH or HOY Horse of the Year within twelve months of the downgrade being approved.

Conditions

1. Points are attributed to combination not the horse.
2. In the event of a tie in any Leaderboard level, the combination with the highest placing at the South Island Festival of Dressage for South Island Series and Horse of the Year for the North Island Series will be the winner. In the event of a tie in for the overall Hi-Points, the highest level will win
3. Ponies will be allocated points based on their placing in the overall class
4. CD's only, no cassette tapes, re-writable CD's or USB



Championships

1. Points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th in all classes for scores above 57%
2. Points are allocated 30 for 1st to 1.5 for 20th in all classes denoted by ** for scores above 57%
3. **For Grade Champions & Reserves: Level 1 – Level 9:** The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Championship winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the ** Class is the winner. If there is still a tie, the combination with the highest average % will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the combination with the highest aggregate collective marks in the final ** will be the winner.

Changes to level 6/7 & 8/9 Championships:

1. Advanced Level, Level 6 Championship, for horses that have gained less than 30 points in Level 7 at date of close of entry. **Ie: Horses that have gained more than 60 points in level 7 may not contest the Level 6 Championship but can contest the Level 7 Championship.**
2. Grand Prix, Level 8 Championship, for horses that have gained less than 30 points in Level 9 at date of close of entry. **Ie: Horses that have gained more than 60 points in level 9 may not contest the Level 8 Championship but can contest the Level 9 Championship.**
3. These restrictions do not apply if the horse is competed by a rider of Category C7 or below

South Island Super 5 League

1. All Super 5 League classes must be ridden from memory
2. If entries for Super 5 League Competitions exceed 30, they may be split into two divisions. However, each division must have a minimum of 15 entries.
3. The Super 5 League qualifiers are open to any registered horse/pony under Article 460 (2017) to enter in the Level of their choice.
4. Horses/Ponies may start in more than one Super 5 Qualifier per event if eligible according to Article 460 (Grading of Horses & Ponies)

General Venue Conditions

1. Dogs must be on a lead at all times.
2. No smoking in any buildings or in stable areas.
3. Canterbury Dressage nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
4. Canterbury Dressage shall not be liable for the safety of any goods/equipment or the loss of, or damage to such goods and equipment, brought in/stored at the venue, during the period of use.
5. Any damage to SINEC facilities to be reported immediately to the Office.
6. Safety hats must be worn at all times when schooling at the SINEC
7. All horses and ponies on the grounds must be entered at the event unless the OC gives express permission otherwise.

Camping

1. Parking and camping areas will be defined. Some areas will be restricted to on site camping/parking only. Day competitors must only park in designated day parking areas.
2. Please be tidy and use bins for all other rubbish.

Horse Identification, Accommodation & Wash Down Bays

1. ESNZ horse identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing. When not competing, all horses should have ID tags or ESNZ numbers attached. It is requested that during non competition times these ID tags also include horse and person responsible name and contact.
2. All yards/pens/stables are to be left properly mucked out. Horse muck bins will be located near each yard/stable area for this purpose.
3. No form of temporary yarding is permitted
4. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times

Code of Conduct

1. In all equestrian sports the horse must be considered paramount.
2. The well-being of the horse shall be above the demands of breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organisers, sponsors or officials.
3. All handling and veterinary treatment must ensure the health and welfare of the horse.
4. The highest standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times.

5. Adequate provision must be made for ventilation, feeding, watering and maintaining a healthy environment during transportation.
6. Emphasis should be placed on increasing education in training and equestrian practices and on promoting scientific studies in equine health.
7. In the interests of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider shall be regarded as essential.
8. All riding and training methods must take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered by the FEI to be abusive.
9. National Federations should establish adequate controls in order that all persons and bodies under their jurisdiction respect the welfare of the horse.
10. The national and international Rules and Regulations in equestrian sport regarding the health and welfare of the horse must be adhered to not only during national and international events, but also in training.
11. Competition Rules and Regulations shall be continually reviewed to ensure such welfare.
