Important Information

Responsibility: It is the rider, or person responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

1. **ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without ESNZ rider and horse registrations current to the 29 November 2020. Annual Dressage start only needed to enter all DNZ Series, Island or National Championships, Horse of the Year, and international events, other classes may be entered using a flexi start.
2. **ESNZ Registration for Non Graded Classes:** All riders must be a Full or Introductory member current to 29 November 2020 or pay a \$15 Casual membership. Horses and Ponies may be registered, use a flexi start or not be registered.
3. **Rules:** Canterbury Dressage Premier League competition will be run under the current (Version2020) ESNZ GR's, VR's and ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
4. **Official start time:** The official event start time is 7.30 am Saturday 28 November 2020. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note Dressage NZ rule 477 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.
5. **Official finish time:** The official finish time will be sixty minutes after the completion of the last class or once all presentations for the event are completed, whichever is the latter.
6. **Protests:** Must be lodged within 60 minutes of the official finish time in writing, including a non refundable fee of \$50.00.
7. **Qualifiers:** Premier League Shows are qualifiers for the Horse of the Year.
8. **Dressage NZ Leagues/Series:** Horses/Ponies must have an annual start for Dressage to gain points in any Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize, AMS Pony and Young Rider Performance Leagues, or Top 10 League. Riders must register online at Equestrian Entries prior to 28 November 2020 for inclusion in any Top 10 League, Prestige Dressage Futures Prize, AMS Saddlery Pony and Young Rider Performance Leagues.
9. **Tests:** All tests from DNZ Test book version 2019 Reprint 1 or FEI Website.
10. **Pony Classes:** Ponies may contest the Zilco and/or Super 5 classes which run as a separate National competition. These classes will not count towards the **pony** individual level championship.

Event Conditions

1. **If applicable, where the Covid-19 Alert level at the time of the event requires a limit on gatherings, entries will be limited and/or reduced, on a first in and first served basis.**
2. **Amendments:** The Organising Committee (OC) reserves the right to alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
3. **Hampden Oval:** Unregistered, preliminary and novice classes may be held on the Hampden Oval (irrigated grass surface).
4. **Presentation of Prizes and Prize Money:** See DNZ Rule article 485.
 - a. All riders must attend advertised presentations. The organising committee reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a placegetter not attend an advertised prize giving.
 - b. All prize money will be paid by direct credit within 21 days of the event. The OC reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a place getter not attend an advertised prize giving. Riders who have conflicting class times must nominate another person to Sally Steele (Office Manager) via the event office to collect their prizes/rosettes at the prize giving. Please ensure your bank account details are loaded on Equestrian Entries, this is your responsibility as we will not be contacting you if you have not listed it. No prize money will be paid after 15 January 2021.

5. **Prize Givings: Saturday** - Unmounted for all classes. **Sunday** - Unmounted for all classes and Champions & Reserves, Super 5 League and Zilco Musical Freestyles. Times will be advised.
6. **Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available by 7.00 pm on the results board. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
7. **Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
8. **Riders with more than two horses:** The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, the maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
9. **Hats:** ESNZ approved and tagged riding hats must be worn at all times, at all levels, during the competition.
10. **Non Competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the organising committee gives permission otherwise.
11. **Media:** Canterbury Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of Canterbury Dressage.
12. **Music for Freestyles:** Please ensure this is handed to the music caravan at least two hours prior to the start of your class. Music must be either be saved on a CD or USB as an either MP3 or video file.
13. **Stallions** must comply with ESNZ Article 147 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
14. **Liability:**
 - a. Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
 - b. SI National Equestrian Centre, Dressage NZ or Dressage Canterbury nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
 - c. SI National Equestrian Centre, Dressage NZ or Dressage Canterbury shall not be liable for the safety of any goods/equipment or the loss of, or damage to such, brought in/stored at the venue, during the event.
15. **Health & Safety:**
 - a. Dressage NZ and Canterbury Dressage are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
 - b. Competitors must comply with appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
 - c. Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event
 - d. All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, and the Canterbury Dressage health and safety policy's.
 - e. Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
 - f. Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed.
 - g. Any hazards identified must be reported to event office.
 - h. Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and following event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put a risk by their actions.
16. **ESNZ Concussion Policy:**
 - a. This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
 - b. Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
 - c. Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing.
17. **ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy** - ESNZ reserve the right to drug or alcohol test any participant at the event under the ESNZ Drug & Alcohol Policy 2020. This link will access the policy and frequently asked question.

Entry Conditions

1. Entries close on Friday 6 November 2020, 9pm.
2. Enter online at www.equestrianentries.co.nz. Emailed or phone entries will not be accepted.
3. Entry is not accepted until payment is made.
4. Direct credit payments must be made by close of entry for entry to be accepted.
5. Any changes are to be done through the change request on Equestrian Entries.
6. Payment to be made to Canterbury Dressage MEF Account: 02 0820 0359529 00 with name and rider ESNZ registration number as reference.
7. Draw will be available at www.equestrianentries.co.nz with the latest up-to-date version available 27 November 2020.
8. Horses and ponies are restricted to three starts per day. Riders are limited to three horses.
9. Prize money will only be paid out on scores of 57% and above.
10. Any scratchings or withdrawals made prior to 5pm, 27 November 2020 must be emailed to haigequestrian@gmail.com. Scratchings or withdrawals after this, or throughout the duration of the show are to be text to 021435233, or communicated through the event office.
11. Closing date for all refund applications is 3pm Friday 4 December 2020. There will be no refund, where the request is not accompanied by a doctor/vet/farrier certificate, and sent to the Treasurer, Bailey McIntosh – mcintosh.bailey@gmail.com
12. \$25 per rider event levy and Equestrian Entries on-line fees are non refundable.
13. If a rider scratches before payment is made, payment is still required to be made for the rider event levy and the Equestrian Entries on-line fee.

Awards Eligibility

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only.
2. **Young Rider Award:** Open to riders on horse or pony. Rider must be 20 years or under as at 1st August 2020. **Please enter this class on Equestrian Entries (no fee).**
3. **Masters Award:** Open to riders on horse or pony. Riders must be aged 50 years or over as at 1st August 2020. **Please enter this class on Equestrian Entries (no fee).**
4. **Pony Award:** Open to ponies, rider must be 16 years or under as at 1st August 2020. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st to 4th placing within the class. **Please enter this class on Equestrian Entries (no fee).**
5. **Sophie Luddington Memorial Trophy:** Young Riders Level 3 and above on hacks. **Please enter this class on Equestrian Entries (no fee).**
6. **Hanoverian Society Award:** Two awards presented Level 1-3 and Level 4 and above. The award will be presented to the highest-level Hanoverian champion, if no champion then the reserve. If there is neither the Sash will lapse for that grade this year. Horses must be registered with NZ Hanoverian

Society. **Please enter this class on Equestrian Entries (no fee).**

Championship Points Levels 1-9

1. Championship points are allocated 20 for 1st, to 1 for 20th in all classes.
2. Points are allocated 30 for 1st to 1.5 for 20th in all classes denoted by **.
3. Points towards the Championship will only be awarded for scores of 57% and above.
4. Champions and Reserves: The horse with the highest aggregate allocated points from specified classes will be the Championship winner. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest place in the ** class is the winner. If there is still a tie, the combination with the highest aggregate collective marks in the final qualifier will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the combination with the highest average % in the final ** will be the winner.

Championship Points Young Riders Award, Masters Award and Pony Award

Championship points are allocated as below.

1. In the event of a tie, the combination with the highest average % will be the winner. If there is a further tie, the horse contesting the highest level will be the winner.

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

All competition arenas are closed at all times except as stated below.

1. These times may be amended please check times in rider notes provided with the draw.
2. Arena familiarisation is not intended to be used as a full schooling session.
3. Riders need to be considerate of other riders wishing to familiarise their horses.
4. Lunging to be in the lunging arena only.
5. Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace around the exterior of the competition arena

- unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate.
6. Familiarisation will include all competition arenas.
 7. **Familiarisation Times:** Friday 27 November 4pm – 5pm, Saturday 28 November 6.45 – 7:15am.

Horse Identification, Venue, Stabling, Accommodation Conditions

1. Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing.
2. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags also that include, person responsible name and mobile phone contact number.
3. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out. If not a fee of \$50 will be charged.
4. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
5. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
6. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Stable Manager.
7. Please use the skips provided for horse waste not rubbish, wheelie bins are provided for rubbish only.
8. No smoking in any buildings or stable areas.
9. Damage to SINEC facilities to be reported to the Event Office.

Dogs

1. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and must be kept at least ten metres away from a competition arena.
2. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damage/harm caused by the dog at the competition.

Camping & Power Sites

1. Trucks and Campervans requesting power must have a valid electrical certificate and under no circumstances will allow other vehicles to connect to their vehicle via extension cords.
2. Please be tidy and use green wheelie bins for all rubbish – no animal waste in green bins.
3. Waste and grey water tanks must only be emptied in designated waste water dumps.

Professional Services

1. Equine Therapists and Treatment
 - a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarian and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event in a private or commercial basis must notify the Organising Committee of any treatment prior to the event.
 - b. All practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.
 - c. Riders who own their equipment (eg Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.
 - d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event will be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

2. Other Professionals

- a. Any other professional intending on providing services at this event must obtain prior agreement from the Organising Committee – this excludes professionals Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors

Code of Conduct

- In all equestrian sports the horse must be considered paramount.
- The well-being of the horse shall be above the demands of breeders, trainers, riders, owners, dealers, organisers, sponsors or officials.
- All handling and veterinary treatment must ensure the health and welfare of the horse.
- The highest standards of nutrition, health, sanitation and safety shall be encouraged and maintained at all times.
- Adequate provision must be made for ventilation, feeding, watering and maintaining a healthy environment during transportation.
- Emphasis should be placed on increasing education in training and equestrian practices and on promoting scientific studies in equine health.
- In the interests of the horse, the fitness and competence of the rider shall be regarded as essential.
- All riding and training methods must take account of the horse as a living entity and must not include any technique considered by the FEI to be abusive.
- National Federations should establish adequate controls in order that all persons and bodies under their jurisdiction respect the welfare of the horse.
- The national and international Rules and Regulations in equestrian sport regarding the health and welfare of the horse must be adhered to not only during national and international events, but also in training.
- Competition Rules and Regulations shall be continually reviewed to ensure such welfare.
